

American Made Program (DOE)

DOE's **American-Made program** accelerates technology development or community-based clean energy deployment through cash prizes, training, and more.

Many previous prizes have supported community-based economic development and workforce training:

- Community Clean Energy Coalition Prize
- Inclusive Energy Innovation Prize
- Energizing Rural Communities Prize
- Community Energy Innovation Prize



Good Jobs in Clean Energy Prize (DOE)

- One of the Department of Energy's current American-Made Challenges, the **Good Jobs in Clean Energy Prize** seeks to encourage the formation of place-based coalitions focused on creating good jobs in clean energy.
- Cash prizes of \$50k per coalition in Phase One, and up to \$450k across three phases.
- Coalitions must include at least one entity from each of the following: labor organization, clean energy employer, community-based organization, public agencies, and education and workforce provider.



Deadline: Jan. 31, 2025

DOE's [Office of State and Community Energy Programs \(SCEP\)](#) provides funding and technical assistance to states, territories, and DC to enhance energy security, advance state-led energy initiatives, and increase energy affordability.


