



The CEBN was founded by **The Pew Charitable Trusts** in 2009 to inform and engage clean energy business leaders in policy.



It transitioned in May 2017 to become an independent, small business initiative of the Business Council for Sustainable Energy—a 26-year-old coalition of leading trade associations, corporations, and utilities working to advance market opportunities for energy efficiency, renewable energy, and natural gas. 
The CEBN serves as a bridge to promote policy and industry collaboration between small businesses and the highly-connected group of clean energy influencers represented by the BCSE.


