





ENERGIZING RURAL COMMUNITIES PRIZE

This prize awards up to \$300,000 to organizations or companies taking steps to develop clean energy projects in rural or remote communities.

What type of projects are eligible to compete?

Projects that take the first steps necessary to developing a clean energy project (no construction needed)



- Partner Track: facilitate new or existing partnership that enable the development of clean energy projects
- Finance Track: connect communities to capital for current or future clean energy projects

Phase 1: closes May 24, 2023 - \$100,000 each for up to 90 winners

SBIR / STTR PROGRAM

The Small Business Innovation Research / Small Business Technology Transfer (SBIR/STTR) programs offer equity-free funding for innovating and commercializing new technologies at eleven federal agencies.

The <u>Department of Energy</u> offers two solicitations for SBIR/STTR Phase 1 funding every year.

- Topics are released in July and November, with full applications due in October and February respectively.
- Phase 1 offers ~\$200,000 in funding and the opportunity to apply for additional funding in Phase 2.
